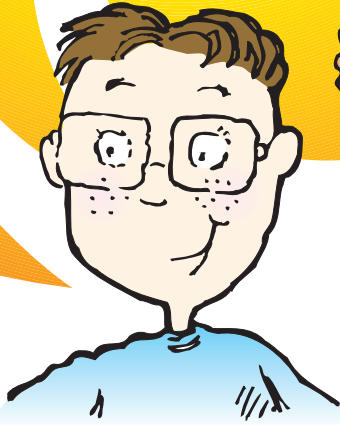

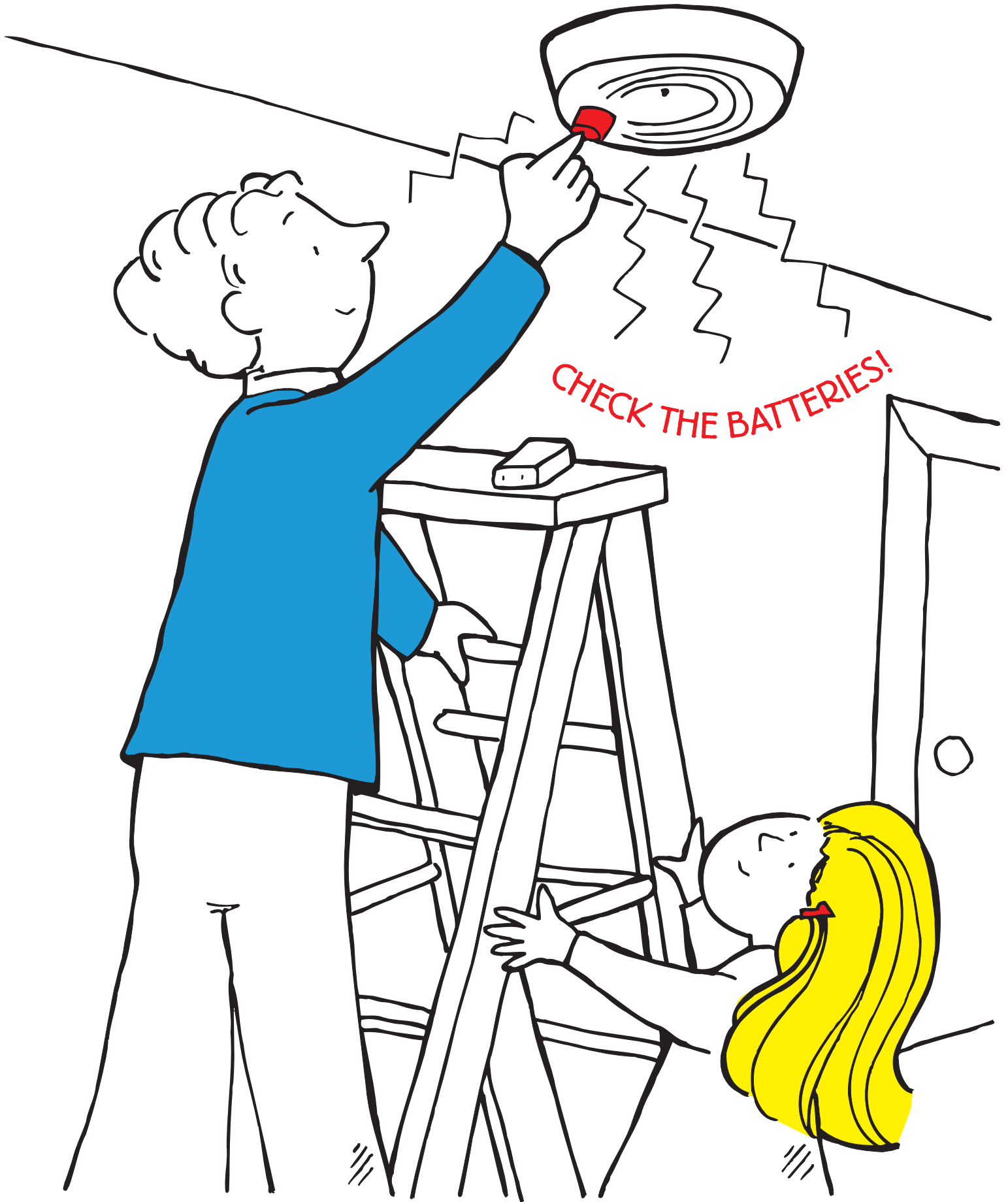
We're all familiar with different types of heat and fire like birthday candles, fireplaces and stoves. It's important to respect fire.



If you see matches or lighters, don't touch them. Tell a grown-up. **Never play with fire.** Fire is dangerous. It can burn you and it spreads very quickly.



Have **smoke detectors** and test them regularly with your parents to make sure they are working properly. Smoke detectors save lives.



If you're on fire, "STOP, DROP and ROLL".
Practice this so you know how to do it.



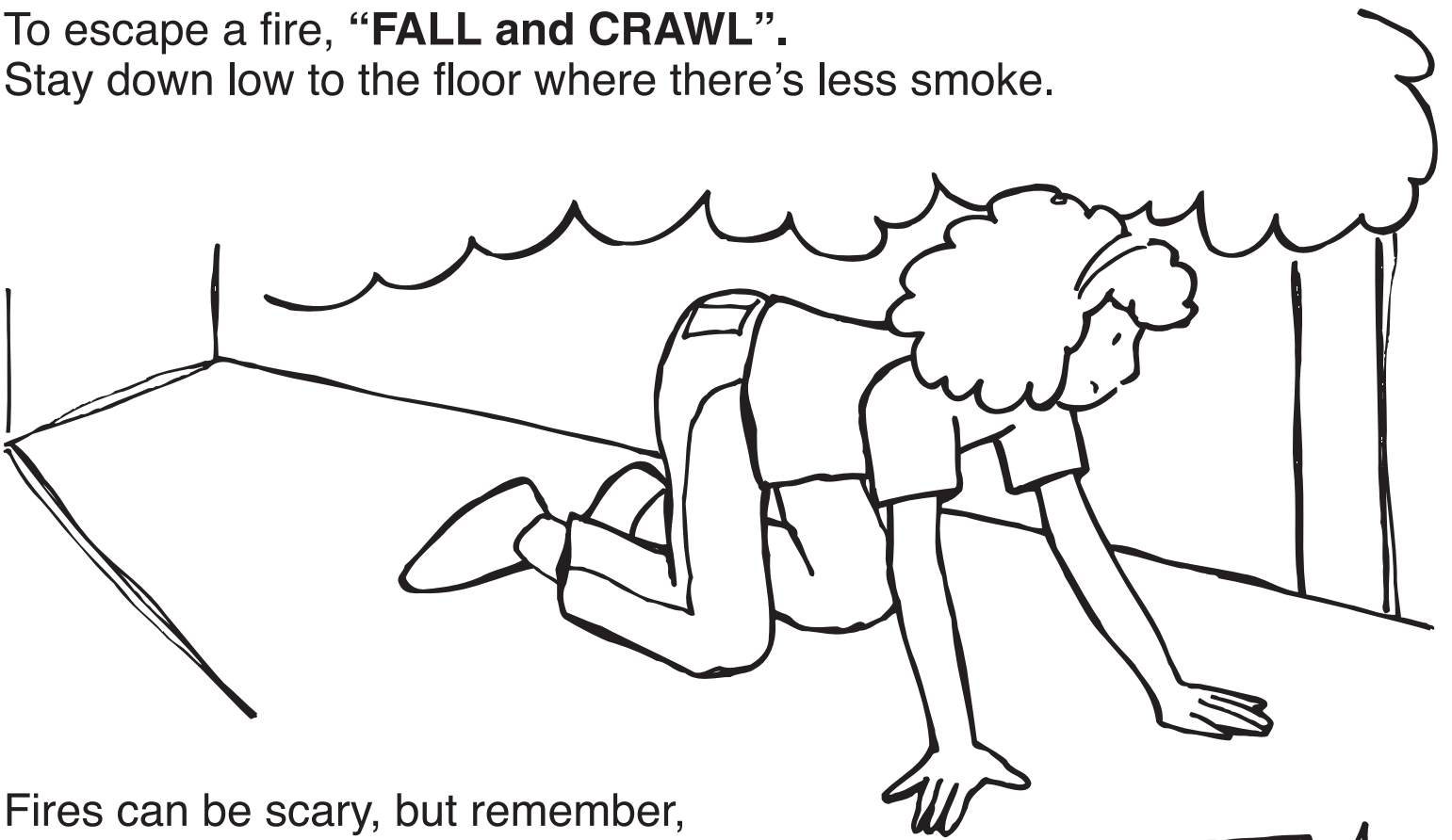
Have a **fire escape plan** and practice it with your family. Make sure you have a family meeting place outside.



In a fire, always touch a closed door before opening, if it is too hot to touch, don't open it... Look for another way out!



To escape a fire, **“FALL and CRAWL”**.
Stay down low to the floor where there’s less smoke.



Fires can be scary, but remember,
“DON’T HIDE, GO OUTSIDE!”
